We will discuss **how to piece all of this together** during this initial class.

1. Describe one character's problem, or a choice made. What effect does this choice have on the character in the story? Write a paragraph that describes the choice and a paragraph that explains the impact.
2. What role does the character's environment have on him/her? One paragraph
3. Copy an interesting/important/enjoyable passage (**note the page number**) from the work and comment on it in a paragraph.
4. Examine the virtue of a character you like/dislike. Write a paragraph in which you explain the virtue and why it is important to the development of the character.
5. Conflict is a part of every story. Select either an internal **or** external conflict. Describe it in your own words and discuss if the character overcomes or succumbs to the conflict in a paragraph.
